


TOWN OF GUILFORD SELECTPERSON'S MEETING
July 14, 2020

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chair Bill Thompson. Present in addition to Chair Bill Thompson and Manager Johanna Turner were selectmen Mike Dexter, Kent Burdin, Peter Martell, and Paul Zimmerman, Road Commissioner Jeff Libby.
2. Motion was made and seconded to approve minutes of June 2020 minutes. Unanimous
3. Balance Sheets were distributed and reviewed.
4. Guests Scheduled: none
5. Correspondence: The manager reviewed with the board correspondence received by a resident with concerns regarding the handling of roads being blocked off during the last major storm of the winter season. Discussion was held regarding the concerns which were also addressed with Public Works Supervisor. With the board being satisfied with the management of the situation, no further action was taken. Correspondence was also reviewed from Guilford Historical Society and Guilford-Sangerville Sanitary District. The Town Manager will respond to the correspondence accordingly.
6. Old Business: There was no old business to discuss.
7. Manager Report – Town manager provided the board a brief update relating to town business: the town office will be closed on August 4th and 5th so that both front end staff members can attend motor vehicle training. A claim was placed with MMA to cover a fire hose which was damaged en route to a fire call in June. The Town was awarded \$45908.00 as part of the State of Maine's Keep ME Healthy Grant. The funds will be used for public assistance and education as well as to absorb some of the municipal costs related to COVID-19.
8. The manager informed the board that the assessor will be on site on Wednesday, July 15th to commit taxes, the manager discussed some projections regarding state revenue sharing, homestead exemption increase and how these would impact the mill rate. A motion was made and seconded to allow the Town Manger to commit taxes at the rate which would allow for the maximum overlay. Unanimous
9. Other Business - There was no other business to discuss.
10. Having no further business, it was moved and seconded to adjourn at 8:02- p.m.
