- 1. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chair Bill Thompson. Present in addition to Chair Bill Thompson and Manager Johanna Turner were selectmen Mike Dexter, Kent Burdin, Peter Martell, and Paul Zimmerman, Road Commissioner Jeff Libby.**
- 2. Motion was made and seconded to approve minutes of May 2020 minutes. Unanimous**
- 3. Balance Sheets were distributed and reviewed.**
- 4. Guests Scheduled: none**
- 5. Correspondence: The manager had none to present.**
- 6. Old Business: Jeff Libby, Road Commissioner, was present to answer any follow up questions the board may have regarding the road study which was distributed last month. There were no questions with the material presented.**

The Manager will keep the board informed as information is available. The Manager gave the board the plan that the library board along with the director had developed regarding reopening. There were no questions or concerns with the plan.**
- 9. Warrant for 2020 Town Meeting – The warrant for the 2020 Annual Town Meeting was presented to the board for review, approval, and signatures. The approved warrant will be posted at the town office, the post office, Duvaltex and Hardwood Products.**
- 10. Piscataquis Country Club Liquor License Renewal: A renewal application was submitted by Piscataquis Country Club for their liquor license. There were no concerns regarding the approval of this renewal. A motion was made and seconded to approval the renewal of the Piscataquis Country Club Liquor License. Unanimous.**
- 11. Other Business - The manager relayed to the board that she was informed informally on Monday morning that President Donald Trump was intending to pay a visit to the Town of Guilford on Friday, June 5<sup>th</sup> 2020 in order to honor the work**

that is being done at Puritan Medical Products in the production of the testing swabs critical for the testing of COVID-19. Not a lot of details about the visit are available at this time. The Manager will keep the board informed of details regarding the visit as they become available.
